After well over 10 years of lobbing our New York Senators and Congressmen, on April 6, 2022, President Biden signed the Postal Service Reform Act into law. This should ensure America's Postal Service remains viable for many years to come. The Postal Service Reform Act includes many provisions that the NYRLCA and the NRLCA have advocated for years that should allow the Postal Service to achieve financial stability. During this year's annual legislative seminar in May, we were able to meet with Senate Majority Leader Schumer and thank him for his never ending efforts to get this postal reform legislation passed in a bipartisan manner.
